TABERNACLE BIBLE REFERENCES

Chapters 25–31: TABERNACLE INSTRUCTIONS

Ch.25 – Ark, Table, and Lampstand: God gives plans for the tabernacle's furnishings.

Ch.26 – Tabernacle Structure: Details on the tabernacle's curtains and structure.

Ch.27 – Altar and Courtyard: Instructions for the bronze altar and outer court.

Ch.28 – Priestly Garments: Garments for Aaron and his sons as priests.

Ch.29 – Priest Ordination: Process for consecrating the priests.

Ch.30 – Altar of Incense and Atonement: More tabernacle items; incense altar, census tax, anointing oil.

Ch.31 – Craftsmen and the Sabbath: God appoints Bezalel and Oholiab to build the tabernacle; emphasizes Sabbath observance.

Chapters 35-40: TABERNACLE CONSTRUCTED

Ch.35 – Sabbath and Offerings: Moses reminds them to keep the Sabbath; people donate materials.

Ch.36 – Building Begins: Skilled workers start construction; people give generously.

Ch.37 – Ark and Furnishings Made: Ark, table, lampstand, and incense altar are constructed.

Ch.38 – Courtyard and Altar Finished: Bronze altar and court completed; materials accounted for.

Ch.39 – Priestly Garments Made: Priestly garments completed and presented to Moses.

Ch.40 – Tabernacle Set Up: Tabernacle is assembled. God's glory fills it, signifying His presence.

TABERNACLE DESCRIPTIONS AND REFERENCES

Exodus 25-31; 35-40

Primary and most detailed description of the tabernacle and all its furnishings.

Includes instructions and actual construction.

Leviticus

Describes how the tabernacle is to be used in worship and sacrifices.

Lev 1–7: Offerings and sacrificial rituals inside the tabernacle.

Lev 16: The Day of Atonement (use of Most Holy Place).

Lev 24:1–9: Care for the lampstand and bread in the sanctuary.

Numbers

Talks about the layout, transport, and roles related to the tabernacle.

Num 1–4: Levite duties, camp arrangement around the tabernacle.

Num 7: Offerings for the dedication of the tabernacle.

Num 9:15–23: The cloud over the tabernacle guiding Israel.

Num 17: Aaron's rod placed before the ark in the tabernacle.

Deuteronomy

Reflective and legal references to the tabernacle (called "tent of meeting").

Deut 10:1–5: Recounts the making of the ark and tablets.

Deut 12: God's chosen place of worship foreshadowing the temple.

PRIESTLY GARMENTS DESCRIPTIONS AND REFERENCES Exodus 28–29; 39

Full descriptions of garments for the high priest and other priests: Ephod, breastpiece, robe, turban, sash, bells, pomegranates, and linen.

Leviticus

Levitical laws and functions often describe the garments functionally. Lev 8: Ordination of Aaron and sons (garments are put on them). Lev 16: High priest's special linen garments for the Day of Atonement.

Numbers 20:28 Aaron's priestly garments are transferred to Eleazar before Aaron dies.
