### Prophetic Principles:

1. When pictured together, the Little Flock always precedes the Great Company who follows or accompanies the little flock. Examples – the king’s daughter and her companions, Rebekah and her maidens, Elijah and Elisha, wise and foolish virgins.
2. The Great Company is pictured in scripture as a separate class only after the church is completed. It is not recognizable until that time.
3. God always causes prophetic fulfillments to be recorded in history for His watchers to see and recognize.
