{Bill O} Was Moses married twice? Ex. 2:16

- Daughter of priest of Midian Zipporah (vs. 12) [?Ethiopian?]
- Num. 12:1 = Cushite woman. Was Cushite same as Ethiopian & Midianite?

{Bill F} In Acts 16:17-18, A demon possessed medium woman followed after Paul and Silas proclaiming: "These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation." - Paul commanded the evil spirit to depart from her.

- Was there evil intent or strategy in the message she spoke?

{Walt} Regarding R:4836 and R:5761 is there a consecrated class "between the ages"?

- When is "between the ages"?
- Are these a prophetic class or just observed conditions and circumstances?
- What is the nature of such consecrations?

{Jerry} Daniel 11:30 (AV) "For the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy covenant: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant."

- What is the "holy covenant"?
- Br. Russell's thought is that Napoleon goes against the true Church by establishing the Concordant with the Pope.
- However, the verse speaks of "indignation" (some translations have anger or rage).
- Did Napoleon have indignation against the true saints?
- Volume 3, page 47: "On his return from Egypt, Napoleon abandoned his former policy of violent opposition to Papacy, and signed a Concordat or agreement with the pope, by which the Roman Catholic religion was re-established in France. This was an action against the truth; but he seemed to see that by this policy he could best succeed in overturning the Republic and in establishing himself in power as Emperor."
