### STUDY V: Manner of the Second Advent

Each of the paragraphs below have central points. After reading the section, your participation is open as how you understand the material with support, evidence, examples and your own questions.

**117:2** — After his resurrection, Jesus was invisibly present, preparing them for future service. What kind of lessons did our Lord have for his disciples?

**118:1** — Luke 5:4-11 Jesus teaches a lesson for the fishing business. Why were John and Peter convinced that it was Jesus on the shore?

**118:2** — Once they returned to shore, Jesus had more lessons for them.  
John 21:12-14 What was the lesson for the disciples?  
John 21:15-19 What was the lesson for Peter?

**119:1** — Acts 1:3-9 After 40 days, Jesus has some final words. Why did Jesus not give a full answer to the question about when the kingdom will be established? What is the “new (spiritual) Israel” with “power”?

**120:1 - 121:1 (2)** — When they could no longer see Jesus, they began to see something more. What truths were becoming more clear?

**121:2 - 122:1** — Our Lord’s *second* advent. What is similar and different in his second advent?

**122:2** — Seeing and hearing. What can spiritual hearing and seeing understand which cannot with natural ears and eyes?

**123:1** — The purpose for appearing to eyes at the first advent is different at the second advent. What difference does the holy Spirit make in the way Jesus appeared after his resurrection and now?
