Micah 4 & 5 The Judgment of the Leaders Part 2

"... they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: ... neither shall they learn war any more ...". **Micah 4:3**

Chapter 4

1. This chapter starts with a new subject called the "last days".

2. **Verse 3** is one of the most publicly known scriptures and is displayed at the United Nations. (Isa 2:4 ↔ Micah 4:3)

3. **Verse 4** picture of "every man under his vine and under his fig tree" is given as symbols of new home for mankind. Why were those symbols chosen?
Contrast that with our present/future homes? 2 Cor 5:1-9
